1. Authenticity

Romans 12:3

(NLT)

3 Because of the privilege and authority God has given me, I give each of you this warning: Don't think you are better than you really are. Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves, measuring yourselves by the faith God has given us.

2. They don't trust authority

John 5:39 (NLT) "You search the Scriptures because you think they give you eternal life. But the Scriptures point to me!"

3. They are Bible open but also Bible illiterate (true for Gen Z and young millennials)

Proverbs 16:21 (NLT)

21 The wise are known for their understanding,
and pleasant words are persuasive.

4. Give them time for dialogue in small groups.

Colossians 1:9 (NLT)

So we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. We ask God to give you complete knowledge of his will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding.

5. Give action steps to live out your message

James 1:22 (NLT)

But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves.
